



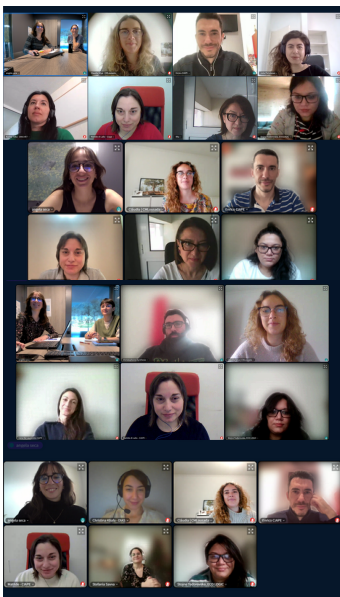
INTERGREEN: RESULTS AND ACHIEVEMENTS

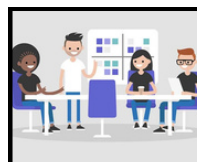
